OFFICE-ORDER

The Ministry of HRD vide letter F.No. 7-149/2015-UT-2(Vol.II) dated 21st March, 2017 has conveyed the approval of Government of India for setting up of 50 new Kendriya Vidyalayas under Civil / Defence Sector all over the country. These Kendriya Vidyalayas are to be opened under the challenge mode, whereby the sponsoring authorities who fulfill the norms of KVS within a specified time frame will be accorded priority on "First come First served" basis, as per lists at Annexure-I & II (copy enclosed).

- 2. The MHRD has also advised KVS to obtain the approval of Board of Governors for the proposals which have been listed as feasible but are yet to be approved by BOG including those cases feasibility of which is yet to be established as mentioned in **Annexure-II.** Accordingly, KVS has obtained approval of the Hon'ble HRM-cum-Chairman KVS to list 11 more proposals as feasible (last 09 cases of **Annexure-I** and first 02 cases of **Annexure-II)** in addition to the 26 proposals already approved feasible by BOG, KVS,
- 3. Further, pursuant to clause –I (ii) of Annexure-I of the norms prescribed for opening of new Kendriya Vidyalayas under Civil Sector, necessary administrative orders for starting new KV will be issued immediately after transfer of land in favour of Kendriya Vidyalaya, its possession to KVS, and also possession of temporary building offered is given to KVS. Therefore, all sponsoring authorities are required to complete these formalities latest by 30th June, 2017 as sanction of these KVs is to be utilized on "First come First served" basis under **challenge mode**.
- 4. Thus 37 cases i.e. 35 cases mentioned in Annexure-I and the first two cases mentioned in Annexure-II have already been approved as feasible by the competent authority of KVS. Hence, the sponsoring authorities in these cases are required to (i) transfer the identified and demarcated land in favour of the new KV (ii) give the physical possession of the land to KVS thereafter, and (iii) to ensure that the temporary accommodation offered is in good condition so that the order for opening these KVs is issued by 30.06.2017.

- 5. In the matter of proposals listed in Annexure-II (other than the first two proposals), the sponsoring authority has to complete all the remaining prerequisites/formalities, already conveyed to them, so as to make and to list the proposal as feasible i.e. a fit case for opening of a new Kendriya Vidyalaya. After establishment of feasibility, remaining formalities as in para 4 above, are to be completed latest by 30th June, 2017 so that the order for opening these KVs is also issued by 30.06.2017.
- 6. It may be noted that in view of sanction of Govt of India for these 50 Kendriya Vidyalayas under challenge mode and "First come First served basis", the sanction may be utilized against another feasible proposal in case a Sponsoring Authority fails to meet the above deadline.
